



Pink Criquet is a new Rosé, born from a winemaking technique called *saignée* (bleeding) that has been utilized at Château Lassègue in Saint-Emilion. The wine's name was inspired by a French rugby player's nickname of "Criquet," because he was small, fast and agile. "Pink" emphasizes that this is a Rosé. Production is limited.

The grapes come from a terroir composed of clay, limestone and sandy gravels. Our Rosé has no malolactic fermentation.

Like a gem in the glass, the wine exhibits vibrant hues of grenadine and cranberry, with a tinge of orange. The nose identifies a floral bouquet, rose petals and wild flowers with an essence of peach and cherry. The mouthfeel is very round and velvety, with a sweetness of Bartlett pears and yellow plums, with a crisp finish. Our Rosé's style is both harmonious and unique thanks to the elegance of the Merlot, the aromatics of the Cabernet Franc and the body of the Cabernet Sauvignon. Enjoy chilled.
